## 5.18 Freedom Park

The 5.18 Freedom Park located just across the Kimdaejung Convention Center is a place where Sangmudae (military court) and military jail during the Democratization Movement are reproduced. The original places of military court and jail was originally located 100m away from the park. At that time people engaged in the Democratization Movement were arrested, tortured, and investigated at the Sangmudae jail. Most of them were referred to the military trials and were eventually died innocently. After Sangmudae was relocated to Jangseong, outskirt of Gwangju City, in March 1998, the site was turned into the park allowing visitors to vividly feel the circumstances at that time. The tour provides visitors with opportunity to watch a short footage, record of the May 18<sup>th</sup> Democratization Movement. Also, during the program visitors will have a chance to take a look at the jail and court and have conversation with citizens who participated in the movement.
